TIPS AND TRICKS FOR SAVING ENERGY THIS WINTER

Regulate your Geyser:

- First things first, use a geyser blanket and insulate the first few meters of water pipes leading to and from the geyser. This additional insulation will keep the water inside the geyser hotter for longer.
- Secondly, monitor the geyser consumption to make sure it does not leak water and have to run longer to keep the water warm, make sure the thermostat is in working order, cycling the element and the that the temperature of the thermostat is set correctly.



Use LED bulbs:

- Did you know that LED light bulbs use 75% less energy than conventional ones do?
- Using less energy will not only save you costs but will also help reduce energy thus decreasing household pollutant to the environment.

How to reduce energy consumption on laundry days:

- Use your tumble dryer sparingly and use a washing line as much as possible.
- Reduce the spin time on your washing machine; the less time it spins, the more you save.
- Pre-soaking reduces the need for heavy wash cycles, saving both time and energy.

Insulate your home:

- Studies suggest that around 50% to 80% of a home's warmth escapes through the ceiling. With proper ceiling insulation, more heat can be retained, reducing the energy required to heat your home during those bone-chilling nights.
